THE MASTER'S MESSAGE

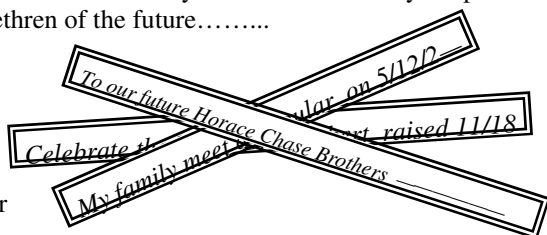
Hello Brethren;
