Hello Brethren;

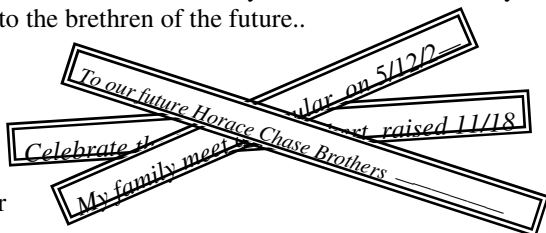
